#### ***Medical Fund :***

##### ***1. Donation for Mechanical Heart Valves :***

Donation of Rs. 5 Lakhs was made to Swami Vivekanand Medical Mission, Khapri, Nagpur, for 10 mechanical heart valves for economically backward and needy patients who are unable to bear the cost of the valves. Mechanical heart valves are artificial replacements for damaged or diseased heart valves, typically made of durable materials like metal or carbon. They are designed to mimic the function of natural heart valves, allowing blood to flow in one direction. This gives a new life to the patient and improves his/her quality of life.

##### ***2. Donation for 10 angioplasties :***

Donation of 3 Lakhs was made to Swami Vivekanand Medical Mission, Khapri, Nagpur, as gap funding for angioplasties for 10 needy underprivileged patients. Total angioplasty expenditure is Rs. 1,20,000/- per patient, Government funding is Rs. 90,000/- . A gap funding of Rs. 30,000/- per patient was donated to help them in getting timely medical help and support.

##### ***3. Jaipur Foot Donation :***

50 Jaipur Foot were donated to 50 people who had lost their foot below the limb in various kinds of accidents leaving them without a leg below the knee. The Jaipur Foot enabled them to walk properly and live a normal life. This project was executed through Mahavir International Service Trust ( List of patients attached )

#### ***B. Education :***

##### ***1. Partnering with Bridge The Gap Foundation by adopting and sponsoring education for Zilla Parishad Schools & Aganwadi's***

We are Partnering with Bridge The Gap Foundation, Nagpur by adopting and sponsoring education for a cluster of schools and aganwadi's in Hingna zone under Zilla Parishad. Nagpur. Bridge the Gap Foundation is a non-profit organization in Nagpur, India, founded in 2021. Its primary mission is to address the educational

gap between rural and urban children by providing quality education and resources to rural areas. They focus on practical, experiential learning and collaborating with local communities and partners to create a supportive ecosystem for rural education. They work with Anganwadis (rural preschools), supporting teachers and implementing relevant teaching methodologies. They also conduct placement drives and other initiatives to empower rural youth. They are currently impacting over 3,000 rural children through their program.

### ***C. Promoting Sports :***

**1. Shri N.K.Garg Memorial Badminton Tournament :** the third Tournament of Shri N.K.Garg Memorial Series, Nagpur was held from 25th to 28th June 2025 at Arundhati Arun Badminton Academy, Besa, Besa, Nagpur. This year the first Maharashtra State Under – 19 Selection Badminton Tournament 2025 was sponsored by N.K.Garg Foundation & Diffusion Engineers Limited and organised by Nagpur District Badminton Association. This Tournament holds key importance as it is an official selection event for Team Maharashtra Under-19 which will represent the State at the West Zone Badminton Championship 2025-26. The Tournament had good participation of 247 entries and 196 players from all over Maharashtra. The Shri N.K.Garg Memorial Tournament is held annually in memory of Shri N.K.Garg. Founder Chairman and Managing Director of Diffusion Engineers Limited with an aim to promote sports.

### ***2. Developing & Donation of Football ground and Sports Equipment :***

Friends Sports Academy (FSA) is a grassroots football initiative based in Nagpur, working consistently to engage youth in sports and guide them towards a disciplined and positive lifestyle.

The journey of the club began in 1996 in Chankapur, originally known as IFFC Chankapur. It was started by children of coal mine workers who had very limited resources but a deep passion for football. In those early days, they did not even have a proper ball and would play using plastic waste and coconuts. Despite these challenges, the love for the game kept them together and slowly built a strong local football culture. Over the years, the club became more than just a place to play—it became a support system for young people in the Chankapur mining area. Through regular sports activity, the club has tried to keep children away from alcohol, drugs, and other harmful influences, while encouraging discipline, teamwork, and focus.

They have the following divisions which compete with other football teams. 1. Elite 2. Super, 3. Senior 4. Women's 5. First 6. Under 14 and Under 17.

As time progressed, many players from Chankapur moved to Nagpur for education, jobs, and better opportunities. However, their attachment to the club remained strong. For the past 6 years, members and senior players have been continuously trying to secure a ground in Nagpur, as travelling regularly to Chankapur became difficult for many players who are now based in the city.

After consistent efforts, they have finally acquired a ground in Nagpur on a 5-year lease. This is a very important step forward for the club and all its players.

At present, the academy has:

- \* More than 100 senior players (18+) registered and playing under the Nagpur District Football Association
- \* Over 100 young children connected to the academy and undergoing regular training
- \* Ongoing engagement with children in Chankapur area, although maintaining numbers is challenging.

This ground will not only benefit current players but will also help reach more children and strengthen efforts to promote sports and positive development in the community.

Hence, after identifying a suitable area in Nagpur belonging to Ram Mandir Trust. Takli. on a 5 year lease, Diffusion Engineers Limited is helping with ground rent of Rs. 50,000 at Rs. 25,000 per month for February and March which was donated to FSA, along with helping them with developing the raw area to make it playable with basic work like leveling, fencing, goalposts, and training facilities into a proper football ground. Rs. 1.20 Lakhs.

Football kits which includes T-shirt, Bib, Travel T-shirt, socks, shoes and a kit bag for 100 players were also donated at Rs. 2000 per kit. Total 2 lakhs.

## **D. Provision of Basic Needs :**

### ***1. RO Plant For Nagpur Police:***

Diffusion Engineers Limited donated an RO Plant for the welfare of Nagpur Police. The plant was Installed at Police Line Takli which is a prominent, well-connected administrative-residential locality in Nagpur, near Katol Road, predominantly serving as a housing hub for police personnel and their families. It houses Police Head Quarters, Police Playground, Alankar a banquet Hall and Shivaji Stadium. The RO plant which has the capacity of filtering 2000 litres of water per hour will cater to 2000+ police personnel and 900 police families staying there, and additionally to cadets during Recruitment, Training and Games.
